EVENT: Tournament; Will be done as a Postal and scored on Orion, each team will shoot a series of weekly 3x20 3p matches at their home range, and submit their Orion targets for scoring. Targets must be received NLT the following Monday of each week of the tournament. Each team can shoot their entire roster with the top four shooters counting for their team score each week "Sporter" or "Precision". Each team member may only shoot for the initial team they are registered for, and may not switch between Sporter and precision. Late Targets will not be scored, and they will receive a zero for that week's score. Home Postal matches will be run in accordance to the 2016-2018 NATIONAL STANDARD THREE-POSITION AIR RIFLE RULES, for equipment and match format and time, rules section 4.0 & 5.0.

Championship Match; The top qualifying teams from the Postal Tournament will be invited to the championship shoulder-to-shoulder match shoot on Orion paper targets. Championship match will be a 3P 3x20+FINAL (CMP Sanctioned, EIC points awarded) Final will be at the completion of scoring relay #4 and time to resolve any protests in accordance with rule 9.0, Saturday 15 December. For Championship match, all teams will shoot concurrently. Each team will be assigned a single lane with all team members firing that lane in the following relays throughout the match so all teams will have a team member firing in each relay 1 through 4. Coaches that have teams qualify for the championship match will decide which four from your roster will fire in the championship match.

EQUIPMENT: PRECISION and SPORTER
CLASSES Separate categories for competition. Participants may compete in only one category.

COMPETITION
OPEN TO: Teams: Only JROTC programs are eligible. The championship match will be shot as a team completion, and **will not** be split up by service. The top eight individual's shooters from the team match will shoot in the final. Final format will be shot in accordance to rule 10.3 for paper targets.

RULES: Current National Three-Position Air Rifle Rules will apply.

COURSE: 10 meters; 3X20, 20 shots each position (prone, standing, kneeling) in that order. Tournament will be shot on Orion Targets Championship match on Orion paper targets will be used. For the tournament, only Orion Targets 10m Air Rifle 12 Bull Target will be accepted. You can order targets through;

AWARDS: 1st thru 3rd team medals for each category (Precision and Sporter)
1st thru 8th individual medals for each category (Precision and Sporter)
(For the team championship, it **will not** be split up by service. The top three teams are the top three teams)

RANGE: 23203 Bulverde Rd, San Antonio TX 78259, this is dependent on the availability of a suitable space so the venue may change if required.

ENTRY FEES: Team: \$100.00 due at start of Tournament 8 Oct 2018.
(No additional fee for championship match)

Targets must be received no later than 8 October to validate entry into tournament.

ACCOMODATIONS: Numerous hotels are in the immediate area. Call match director MAJ Thomas Groggett for suggestions or assistance.

OTHER: 1. Minimum of 24 firing points for Championship match. Entry will be based on team qualification from the results of the postal tournament. Teams qualifying will be based on the number of lanes, which will be split evenly between Sporter and Precision for championship match (12 each, if the Venue allows additional lanes may be opened). At the end of the tournament, ns if there are not enough teams to fill all lanes. At the discretion of the match director additional teams will be invited from schools that can form an additional team on their roster to make up an additional teams for the Championship match, they will not bump teams that qualified in the Tournament but only be added to fill unclaimed lanes.

2. CMP Individual ID #'s. This is a CMP EIC Cup match and EIC Points will be earned. Complete rosters with CMP # must be submitted to match director no later than 8 October 2018 to be entered into the tournament.

3. Be at the range a minimum of one (1) hour prior to relay time, for equipment inspection. Preparation period begins 10 minutes prior to scheduled relay time.

4. Changing facilities are available.

5. Compressed air will be available.

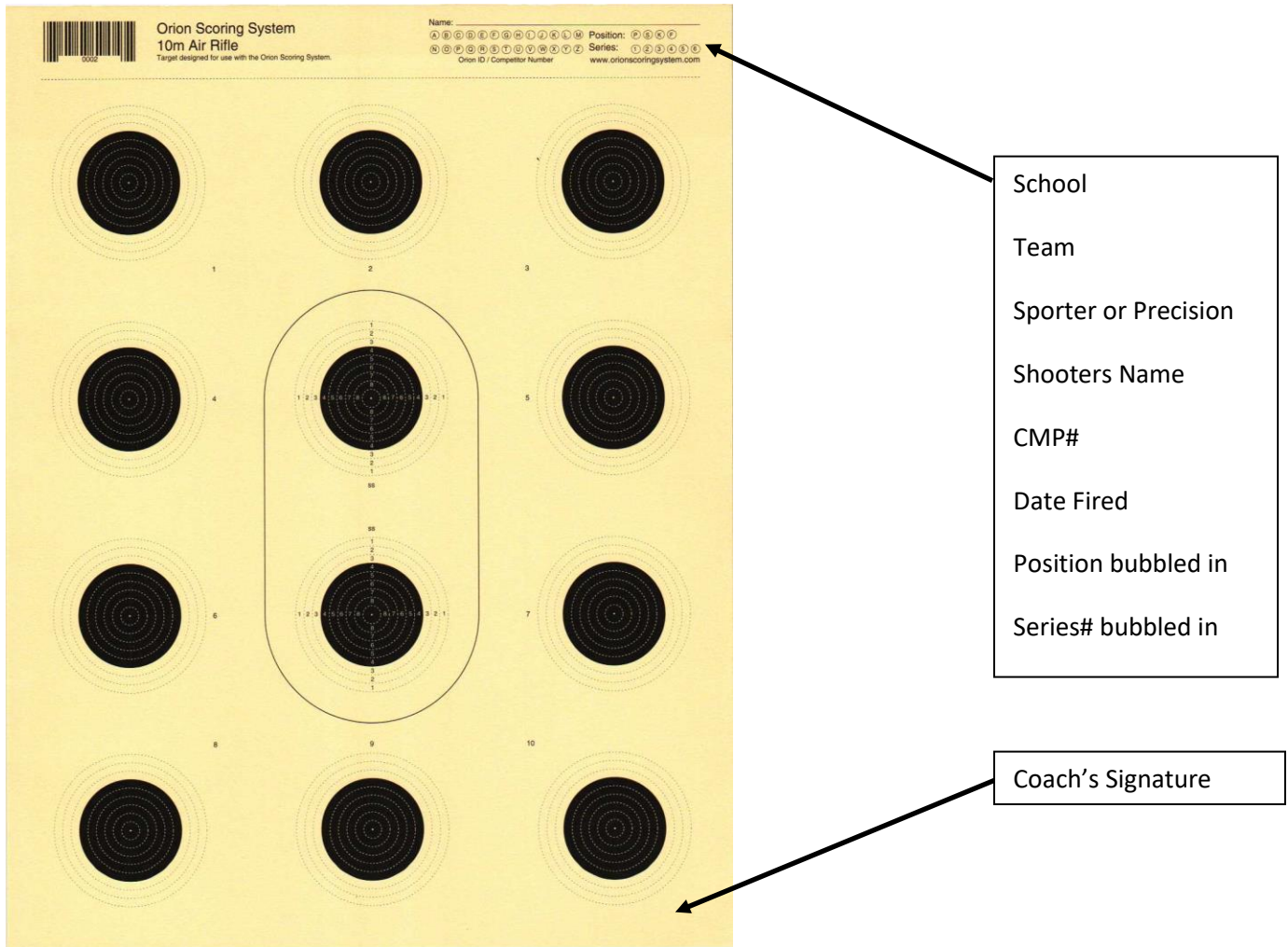

Postal Tournament Target submission

All targets must be shoot on Orion Approved targets; no other targets will be accepted and will disqualify your team for that round.

You will need to clearly print your **School**, **Team**, identify if it is **Sporter** or **Precision**, shooters **Name**, **CMP#** and **Date Fired** in top right corner of target, also clearly bubble in **Position** fired, and **Series#** . Labels may be used as long as all information is provided, and label does not interfere with the scoring area of the target.

Additionally the team coach will sign the bottom right, validating that the target was shot for the position noted and in compliance to Current National Three-Position Air Rifle Rules that apply



Targets must be received NLT the due date, and are to have been shot during the designated time.

Facility and Range Safety Addendum

Request all coaches and instructors read and heed the following information for the safety and care of our JROTC facilities.

1. NO outside snacks, food, drinks or beverages can be brought into the JROTC facility or the Air Rifle Range.
2. NO four (4) wheel equipment carts or transfer boxes from outside schools are to be brought into the JROTC facility or Air Rifle Range.
3. CAUTION: CO2 or Compressed Air Tanks (bulk tanks) are only allowed to be brought into the JROTC facility or Air Rifle range when transported and secured to a two wheel dolly. NO single bulk air tank(s) are allowed to be hand carried/shoulder carried into the JROTC facility.
4. USE OF PELLET DISCHARGE CONTAINERS (PDCs) - Clear all air rifles or discharge air from a rifle into a PDC. DO NOT allow random discharge of air rifles down range.
5. RIFLE CASES – All air rifles must be transported to and from the range and the JROTC facility in a approved rifle case.
