NRA Registered match . You must be a member in good
standing at TSRA to compete in this match. You will be**

required to either show a current membership card or purchase a membership in order to compete.

Rules: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern.

Eligibility: All competitors must be members of TSRA. All competitors will fill out a TSRA membership application. Membership cards and NRA classification cards will be exhibited at time of squadding.

Entries: Will close at 0800 on the day of match. Limited to 50 individual competitors. **No position will be held unless the match form and fees are paid prior to the match. Sending a registration form by e-mail is not a guarantee you will have a firing point.** This will be a paper match only for teams.

Fees: NRA Registration fee.....\$5.50 per competitor

Packages include All match fees, NRA fee, TSRA team support

1 day package\$45.00
Junior entry \$30.00

Advance Entry: Advance entry encouraged, a \$5.00 charge will be added on entries not received by Saturday, October 15th, 2018.

Refunds: Full refund will be made to those unable to attend that notify match director one day in advance. No refunds for no shows!

Time of Firing: Competitors to firing line 0900. Gate to the park and range opens at 0800, volunteers will be at the gate at 7:30 for early entry.

Squadding: All competitors will be assigned target numbers the morning of the match.

Equipment: As per current NRA Rulebook.

Rifle will be rule 3.2 Any Rifle.

Range requires eye and ear protection

Course of Fire: NRA 3-Positions, Outdoor,

Schedule: October 26th , 0900 Metallic Sights only (Staff will be at the gate at 7:30 for entry)

Match 1 50 yards 40 shots Prone for record on A23/5 50 Yard Targets

Match 2 50 yards 40 shots Standing for record on A23/5 50 Yard Targets

Match 3 50 yards 40 shots Kneeling for record on A23/5 50 Yard Targets

Match 4, Aggregate of Match 1-3

Targets: **50 Yards A23/5.**

Team scores will be taken from individual scores. Teams must register prior to the beginning of the match.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. NRA rule 16. **It is the competitors responsibility to review their scores and challenge a target or score within 30 minutes of posting.**

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will fire in the master-unclassified class. NRA Temporary Classifications will be honored provided the competitor presents the Temporary score book to the statistical officer prior to entry. 3 competitors minimum per classification. Classification with less than 3 competitors will be moved up.

Awards: Plaques will be awarded to overall agg winner, first three aggregate winners, Class winners (1 plaque per every five competitors),
