

**TEXAS STATE OUTDOOR PRECISION
PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP
The Greg Yost Memorial Match
Sept 4-5-6, 2020**

LOCATION: The tournament will be held at the Dallas Pistol Club. Located at 1830 W. Beltline Rd. Carrollton TX 75006.

DATE & TIME:

Friday,	Sept 4 th	- Texas Service Pistol Championship
Saturday,	Sept 5 th	- TSRA Precision Pistol Championship & EIC Matches
Sunday,	Sept 6 th	- TSRA Precision Pistol Championship & EIC Matches

RULES: Current CMP and NRA pistol rules will govern in their respective matches: Triggers may be checked at any time during the match. A set of NRA approved trigger weights will be available for competitors to check firearms prior to the match. Triggers will be weighed for the CMP EIC match, CMP .22 EIC Rimfire match and NRA Distinguished Revolver match. Match winners and apparent leg point winners will have their triggers weighed following the match.

Eligibility for Texas Precision Pistol Championship: All competitors must be members of the TSRA. Non-Members who are not a resident of Texas must become a match member for a fee of \$10.00. A match member is a member of TSRA for the duration of the match. All Texas competitors are required to members in good standing of the TSRA.

Eligibility for EIC Matches: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate.

Course of Fire: National Match Course of Fire (see rule 5.2.2 Table 5)

Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Rulebook. All EIC Service Pistol Matches will be governed by CMP Rules.

Eligibility for the NRA Distinguished Revolver Match: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate. See NRA Rule 3.1.4. Revolver firing .38 Special 158 grain lead or Jacketed round nose or semi wad cutter bullets. (see current NRA rules).

Junior Shooter Eligibility: As defined by NRA rule 2.3: Junior - A person may compete as a junior through December 31, of the calendar year in which the twentieth birthday occurs. Juniors under the age of 18 Must have a hand gun authorization form signed by their parent or guardian. A form is included with this program. For young shooters with limited competitive experience please contact Pete Adams to determine their eligibility to compete in this State Match.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used for all matches. Assigned classification (Rule 19.6) may be used in making entry. Classification and TSRA membership cards will be checked at time of registration. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless there are three (3) or more unclassified competitors. In this case a special unclassified class will be provided and awards given.

Shooters may elect to compete in one of the following divisions:

- Open Class
- .22 caliber Only

COVID19 Requirements: The Dallas county and or the Dallas Pistol Club may impose requirements on competitors. These requirements will be enforced and failure to comply will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees. If you are running a fever, have a dry cough, or feel unwell, please do not attend the match.

AWARDS: Awards will be made for the Match winner and first in class. No competitor will be eligible for more than one Award in class.

- First place will be awarded for 3-6 competitors in a class
- Second place will be awarded for 7-11 competitors in a class
- Third place will be awarded for over 12 competitors in a class
- An award will be made to the High Grand Senior, High Senior, High Junior, High Woman, and High Veteran.

If there are less than 3 competitors in the High Master class, High Master shooters will shoot for the win only.

ENTRIES LIMITED: Entries limited to 72 competitors; competitors are urged to send in entries early to ensure a spot on the line. Entry fees can be paid at check in.

POST ENTRIES: Accepted to range limitation, will close at 7:30 A.M. on Sept 4, 2020.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUESTED:

Pre-registration by mail or email is requested. Registration will reserve you place on the firing line. All registrations received will be acknowledged if an email address is provided. You pre-pay or pay when you sign in. Entry form is located at the end of this bulletin.

NOTE: If a competitor pays a package fee but withdraws from competition after having fired any portion of the match, no refund will be given (emergencies excepted). Entry fees will be accepted at the match until the match is full.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: ECIs for guns and EYE and EAR PROTECTION required for all at all times while on the firing line, or under the firing line cover.

MATCH CONDITIONS: Stat office will issue score cards. Scoring will be done down range. Scorers and competitors will sign and turn in the score cards at the end of each match fired. Range personnel will assist in all ways possible to avoid unnecessary delays.

ENTRY FEES: A TSRA Team Support fee is included in registration fee. Fees do not include TSRA membership dues, (required if not a current member).

TEAM MATCH: The team matches will be a fired match. Teams will be made up of three shooters. Match format is 1 team member firing the .22 caliber, 1 team member firing CF, and 1 member firing the .45 cal. Course of fire is a 30 shot National Match Course.

Awards will be made to the team winners providing there is a minimum of three (3) teams in each class.
