The TEXAS STATE RIFLE ASSOCIATION (TSRA) finally was able to hold its LONG RANGE CHAMPIONSHIP Rifle Matches (originally scheduled for April 24-26, and rescheduled because of Covid-19) on October 9-11, 2020 at the BAYOU RIFLES Range south of Houston, Texas. We followed CDC Guidelines and protocol to safely conduct the event. This Championship Event included three 4-Man Team Matches on Friday, October 9, three 20-shot 1000-yard Matches on Saturday, October 10, and two 20-shot 1000 yard Matches on Sunday, October 11. We had 9 Teams including 42 shooters and coaches for Friday's Team Matches, and 62 shooters for the 1000-yard Matches on Saturday and Sunday. These Championships include 4 Tournaments being conducted simultaneously, depending on what rifle discipline you declared for competition. This included SLING RIFLES (includes SERVICE RIFLES, ANY RIFLE/METALLIC SIGHTS, ANY RIFLE/OPTICAL SIGHTS, MATCH RIFLE, and PALMA RIFLE), NRA TACTICAL RIFLE, F-OPEN RIFLE, and F-TR RIFLE. It takes a minimum of five competitors of the same rifle discipline to make a tournament.

The range was in excellent condition. Weather proved to be interesting, as Hurricane Delta was headed close to the range on Friday. We had delay due to fog in the early morning, and the skies were overcast with some drizzle and light rain. The conditions improved so that we could still shoot during the day, but the increasing winds with up to 20mph gusts proved to be challenging for all. Saturday also started with foggy conditions, and had overcast skies, with threatening rain, but less winds (from 5-10mph) out of the northeast. Sunday was more of the same, but the winds were out of the southwest, and the conditions improved during the day. Everyone got all of their shots on target. We finished at 1:30PM Sunday afternoon, presented awards, and everyone had a good time.

Bayou Rifles plans to host this TSRA LONG RANGE CHAMPIONSHIP again next year, in April of 2021 (watch for details later).
