

TEXAS STATE RIFLE ASSOCIATION (TSRA) 2022 HIGH POWER CHAMPIONSHIP

Current CMP High Power Rifle rules will govern.

Match Location: Panola County Gun Club FM 2517 SE of Carthage, TX. Please see the map to the range at www.epcgc.com.

Entries: Use the enclosed registration form and mail a check or money order payable to "PCGC Highpower Division" to PCGC TSRA Match 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633. **Entries without payment will not be squadded.** Entries must be received by May 9, 2022. Late entries will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Cancellations after May 10, 2022, may NOT be refunded.

Participants must be TSRA members. TSRA member applications will be available at the match.

Team Entries: **Do not** prepay for the team match. Team entries and entry fees will be accepted on the day of the match.

Capacity: The maximum range capacity is 64 (4 relays). In the event that the matches fill past capacity, post marks will be used to determine squadding, and a standby list will be developed.

CMP Liability Release: A release must be on file with the CMP. If you need to complete a release form, you can find one at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>.

Squadding: The 800-point CMP Cup Match will be pre-squadded with entry. Team and EIC matches will be squadded on the firing line. Pre-registration for the EIC match is preferred, but day-of entries will also be accepted.

Pit Service: Competitors will be required to perform scoring and pit duties. Paid pullers will not be provided.

Classifications: CMP or NRA classifications will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Challenges: A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

Sighting Shots: 2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the LEG matches.

Targets: Targets to be used are the 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1.

Time of Firing: Check-in closes at 7:00 a.m. Pits will be sealed at 7:15a.m. Firing will begin at 7:30 a.m. each day.

Schedule of Events:

- Friday, May 20, 2022
2X30 Team Match, **firing begins at 07:30**. Cup Event Rule 5.7: Each team member fires 10 shots standing, 10 shots prone rapid, 10 shots prone slow fire + sighting shots.

FOLLOWED BY

Garand, Springfield, (Modern) Military (30 shots), **firing begins at noon or 30 minutes after conclusion of team match – whichever is later**. CMP Games Rules 4.5, 4.6.1, 4.6.2, 4.6.3, 4.6.4, 5.2.2 thru 5.2.7: 5 sighters then 10 shots each slow prone, rapid prone from standing, and standing; all at 200 yards.

OR

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially with .22 first). **Firing begins at 12:30**.

- Saturday, May 21, 2022: 800-Point CMP Cup Match (Cup Event Rule 5.5), **firing begins at 07:30**.
- Sunday, May 22, 2022
Rifle EIC (Leg) Match (CMP Highpower Rifle Rule 8.3), **firing begins at 07:30**.

FOLLOWED BY

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially with .22 first). **Firing begins at 12:30 or 30 minutes after conclusion of Rifle EIC match – whichever is later**.

AWARDS

Team Match: The top three teams, regardless of classification or rifle type, will be recognized.

Individual Awards:

- The match winner of the 800-point CMP Cup Match will be the 2021 TSRA State High Power Champion regardless of type of rifle used, i.e., service or match.
- CMP Medals will be presented to the first, second, and third place winners, i.e., the top three scores, regardless of rifle type.

- Place awards will be made by rifle type, provided that there are five entries within a particular rifle type.
- Classification awards will also be made provided that there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only. Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.
- The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.
- Special awards for High Senior, High Junior, and High Woman will be recognized only if there are three (3) or more in that category. Match winners are not eligible for special awards.

CMP EIC match: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of match results.

Highlighted Safety Notes/ Additional Range Procedures – competitor is responsible for **ALL** published CMP and posted range-specific rules

- The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required at all times except while actually firing or during the preparation time.
- Level-loading is required.
- Hearing Protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.
- For CMP matches, eye protection must be worn by all competitors and competition officials, including Scorers and verifiers, when on the firing line. Eye protection must have two complete lenses and remain in front of the competitor's eyes during firing. See the CMP rulebook for complete details.
- Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties. Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- All brass must be picked up. Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.
- Speed limit on range roads is 15 mph
- Competitors must drive or ride to/from the 600-yard line and the pits; no walking back/forth.
