



TSRA Foundation 2022-2023 Memorial Scholarships In Memory of Mr. “Paul Bartlett” & Mrs. “Kitty Benson”

Note: Bartlett & Benson Scholarship applications are due in the TSRA office by June 15, 2022

The Texas State Rifle Association Foundation (“TSRAF”) will be awarding two scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. One in memory of TSRA Past-President Paul Bartlett and one in memory of Kitty Benson, volunteer for many years supporting Junior shooting teams in Texas and at the national Matches.

Criteria:

- Applicants may be active in any firearm related discipline.
- Applicants must be a Texas/U.S. resident and a TSRA member.
- High School Seniors may apply but must show proof of acceptance to their selected Texas institution of higher learning.
- Current college students must have an overall GPA of 2.75 or greater on the 4.0 scale to apply.
- Applicants must be enrolled/accepted as a full-time College/University student in Texas. (Graduate students are not eligible.)
- Automatic renewal of awarded scholarship is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the TSRA Foundation Board of Directors annually.
- Applicants may apply for any and all TSRA/TSRAF related scholarships; however, recipient may only be granted one annually.
- Applicant must submit a 250 -500 words, double spaced essay based on the subject of the Missions I or II of the Texas State Rifle Association. (shown below and listed in the TSRA Sportsman)
 - TSRA Mission Statement I- *To champion and support the rights of law-abiding Texans to own, enjoy and use firearms as guaranteed by the constitutions of the State of Texas and the United States of America*
 - TSRA Mission Statement II - *To protect and defend the inalienable rights of the individual Texan to acquire, possess, transport, carry, transfer ownership and enjoy the right to lawful use of firearms for self-preservation, for the defense of family and property, and for the common defense of the republic and the individual liberties of the people.*

Application Evaluation:

The TSRA Scholarship Committee will review applications and submit a recommendation to the TSRA Foundation Board of Directors for award. The Committee will consider the following information in the evaluation of applicants:

- Academic achievement, honors-awards or special accomplishments
- school service (extra-curricular activities/volunteer work)
- Community and or Work experience
- Financial need for scholarship
- Essay quality and content
- Academic or Community references (non-family)
- Applicants are not required to be a competitive shooter but must have experience in a shooting/marksmanship or 2nd amendment activity. (example: 4H, FFA, BSA, SCTP, CMP, NRA or hunting). Currently shooting on a university, TSRA, or USA Shooting team enhances your application

Documentation to submit for a completed application by June 15, 2022:

- Letter demonstrating financial need, personal qualities, and service/volunteer activities. The letter will answer the question: "Why do I need and deserve this Scholarship".
- A brief, yet complete *curriculum vitae* to include transcripts, major or intended major, classification at your High school, College, or University (Freshman, Sophomore etc.).
- Summary of shooting discipline(s), classification, experience, team membership, a copy of classification card(s).
- Three letters of reference, one of which must be from the applicant's shooting coach or mentor, the other two from non-relatives attesting to the applicant's personal qualities and community activities.
- Color Photo - School or Passport type photo, head & shoulders only.
