Directions: Bayou Rifles is located approximately 25 miles south of Houston. Take TX Hwy. 288 south, cross TX Hwy 6, proceed 2.6 miles to Brazoria County Rd. 57 West. Turn right (west) and travel 1.8 miles. The range is on the right side (north) of the road. <http://www.bayourifles.org>

Facilities: Porta Potties at the firing line and pits. Competitors must furnish their own food and drinks.

Rules: CURRENT NRA HIGHPOWER RULES APPLY. This is an NRA Registered Match. Individual scores are eligible for National Records.

Level Loading Rule: The rifle must be pointed at the ground or impact berm when closing the bolt. The 1st violation for the day will result in a warning. Any further violations will result in disqualification from the match.

Empty Chamber Indicator: Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) must be inserted in the rifle chamber at all times while on Bayou Rifles property except during prep and live fire. ECI's are available for purchase.

Coaching: For all competitors (including juniors) - Coaching is only allowed while firing Unlimited Sighters.

Eligibility: Every Competitor must be a current member of the Texas State Rifle Association. Please put your current TSRA number on the entry form. Entries without TSRA numbers will be required to buy an annual membership or show your membership card on the day of the match. Out of state shooters may purchase a 3 day TSRA Pass for \$10.00. This pass is valid for the 3 days of the match only.

Entries: Entry deadline is Monday, October 3, 2022 - Entries received after this date will be charged a \$20 late fee. Email confirmation of entry will be sent. Range Capacity is 92 shooters. A wait list will be created when the number of entries exceeds 92. All fees for wait-listed shooters will be refunded if the shooter does not shoot. The post mark will determine the date of entry for entries with checks and the time/date stamp will be used for credit card entries. There will be no rain-delay dates for these matches. Pre-registration fees will be returned in the case of match cancellation. All fees will be returned if you cancel via email or phone by 6:00 PM on Monday, October 3, 2022. Registration closes at 7:30 AM the day of the match.
YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED UNTIL ENTRY FEES ARE RECEIVED.
All registration is via E-Registration. Payment is via credit card only. See the end of the match program for a link to the E-Registration.

PARKING: Competitor parking will be in the field behind the 600 yard firing line between the ditch and the 800 yard firing berm. If it is too wet, alternate parking will be designated.

Pit Duty: All competitors are expected to perform pit duty. Paid pullers will not be offered by the range and E-Targets WILL NOT be used. All individual competitors will be squadded so that there will be two pullers per target. Two physically limited shooters will not be squadded on the same firing point. Team competition will be conducted with one puller per target. The goal for pit service is 10 seconds or less. A shooter may furnish their own target puller to satisfy the above target service requirements, but the puller will be assigned to another target. A paid puller can only substitute for one competitor at a time. Paid Pullers must have prior experience and must be approved by the match director. If a paid puller is deemed unacceptable by the pit boss, the competitor will be required to perform pit duty for the remainder of the tournament.

Transportation to the pits will be provided by trailers. Personal vehicles are not allowed unless approved by the match director.

All shooters who have a paid pit puller must not study wind conditions or start moving their equipment to the firing line during the time their relay is in the pits. This intent is to not give a competitive advantage to shooters that do not go to the pits.

Team Match Entries: Will be taken on the range Friday, November 12th until 07:30 AM.
DO NOT PRE-PAY TEAM FEES.

Team Entry Fee (Includes 3 Matches with 4 shooters) \$40.00

Challenge Fee: \$3 per challenge must be paid at the time of the challenge. The Challenge Fee must be paid before the challenge is accepted. If the challenge is won, the money will be refunded (rule 16.1 (e)).

Targets: NRA MR-1 and MR-1FC.

Empty Chamber Indicator: Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) must be used. ECI's are available for purchase.

Squadding: Assigned squadding will be used as follows:

On Saturday:

For each tournament, the people who placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the 2020 TSRA MR Championship will be squadded with the HMs for that tournament. The shooters for each tournament will be squadded based on classification, then date/time of entry; HM, then MA, EX, etc.

On Sunday:

For each tournament, squadding will be based on the prior day's scores.

For both days:

F-Open, F-TR and Sling Shooters will be squadded on alternate relays, as much as possible given the number of entries in the various tournaments. The goal is to have the shooters, especially the leaders, in each tournament compete together.

Requests for special squadding are discouraged and in most cases will be denied.

Classifications: NRA Mid-Range classification will be used, please indicate your class on the registration form. Unclassified shooters will shoot in the Master Class.

Scoring: Competitors will score and perform pit duties. Any competitor failing to perform pit or scoring duties may be disqualified.

Challenge Period: Challenge Period ends 30 minutes after the match is posted.

Muzzle Brakes, Compensators and Suppressors Are Not Allowed (Rule 3.61.1)

Ammunition – Ammunition with a caliber larger than .338 is prohibited.

Tournaments: There will be 5 tournaments conducted simultaneously.

It takes 5 competitors to establish a Tournament. If insufficient shooters have entered a tournament then the shooter can be moved to another tournament if the shooter's rifle qualifies under the definition of allowed rifles for that tournament. Any tournament or combined tournament with less than 5 competitors will not receive awards.

Tournament 1 – Any Rifle/Any Sight - Any Rifle/Any Sights - Rule 3.2 ,
Match Rifle - Rule 3.3 and Palma Rifle - Rule 3.31

Tournament 2 - Service Rifle - Rule 3.1(a-e)

Tournament 3 - NRA Mid-Range (Prone) Tactical Rifle (AR) - Rule 3.3.3 (Section 23)

Tournament 4 - F-Open -Section 22 - Rule 3.4(a)

Tournament 5 - F-TR - Section 22 - Rule 3.4(b)

The person firing the top score for each rifle type defined below will be the Mid-Range State Champion regardless of the number of people shooting that type of rifle.

- Any Rifle/Any Sights (Rule 3.2 includes Match Rifle and Palma Rifle)
- Service Rifle (Rules 3.1(a-e))
- F-Open Rifle (Rule 3.4(a))
- F-TR Rifle (Rule 3.4(b))
- NRA Mid-Range (Prone) Tactical Rifle (AR) - Rule 3.3.3

J.J. Conway Mid-Range Trophy – The winner of each tournament will have their name added to the J.J. Conway Mid-Range Championship Trophy displayed at the TSRA Headquarters in Bastrop, TX.

Special Awards – Special Awards are for high score for all Tournaments. Special Awards will be awarded for High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, and High Grand Senior. Tournament winners are not eligible for Special Awards.

Step Match Declaration

Match 9 (Grand Aggregate) of the TSRA Mid-Range State Championship is declared to be an NRA Mid-Range Step Match.

Team Match #2 shall be used to for computing points for the President's Master Rifle Team Coach Medal.

Schedule

FRIDAY – October 7, 2022 – There will be two 4 MAN TEAM MATCHES held back to back. Mid-Range Team Matches consist of 4 man teams with sighters and 20 shots per record per shooter. Coaching is allowed in NRA Team Matches. Each team is responsible for providing a pit puller and a scorer.

08:00 – Firing Begins

Match 1 - Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record for each team member (800 Point AGG). 2 team members will fire at a time with a 47 minute block time per block of 2 shooters. There will be a pit change after the 1st two shooters complete firing.

Match 2 - 2 sighters, 20 shots for record for each team member (800 point AGG). 2 team members will fire at a time with a 47 minute block time per block of 2 shooters. There will be a pit change after the 1st two shooters complete firing.

Match 6 600 Yards – 2 Sighters, 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Match 8 Day 2 Aggregate - Total of Matches 4-6

Match 9 – Championship Aggregate – Total of Matches 1-6

The match director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and/or pit rotations based on the number of shooters, weather and range conditions.

Individual Awards – F-Open, F-TR, Service Rifle and Mid-Range Prone Tactical Rifle - Awards will be given on a per tournament basis for the F-Open, F-TR, Any Rifle, Service Rifle and Mid Range Prone Tactical Rifle Tournaments. A total of 5 or more shooters must be entered in the tournament for any awards to be issued. There must be 3 or more entries in a class to establish a class. If there are fewer than 3 entries in a class they will be combined upward with the next higher class, until a minimum of 3 competitors is reached in the combined class. Combining of classes will start at the lowest class that does not have sufficient entries to establish that class. If the Master Class has insufficient entries to establish a class it may be combined upward into the HM class. The HM Class cannot be combined downward to any other established class.

Individual Awards – Any Rifle/Any Sight Tournament - A total of 5 or more shooters must be entered in the tournament for any awards to be issued. For the Sling Tournament awards will be given for placing in each of the following categories and class

- Any Rifle/Metallic
- Any Rifle/Optic
- There must be 3 or more entries in a class/category(Any Rifle/Metallic, Any Rifle/Optic,) to establish a class/category. If there are fewer than 3 entries in a category, they will be combined with another category in the same class. If there are still fewer than 3 entries after combining all categories in a class, there will be no class awards in that class. All competitors will be moved back to their respective categories and combined with the next higher class, until a minimum of 3 competitors is achieved in the combined class. Combining of classes will start at the lowest class that does not have enough entries to establish that class. If the Master Class has insufficient entries to establish a class, it shall be combined upward into the HM class. The HM Class cannot be combined downward to any other established class.

Individual Award Schedule –An updated award schedule may be posted at the stat office based on the number of entries, sponsorships and match expenses.

Tournament Winner - \$8 (min 5 shooters)

1st in class/category - \$7 (min of 3 shooters)

2nd in class/category - \$6 (min of 7 shooters)

3rd in class/category - \$5 (min of 11 shooters)

Match 9 (Championship Aggregate)

Tournament Winner - \$25 (min 5 shooters)

Second Overall - \$20 (min 12 shooters)

Third Overall - \$15 (min 20 shooters)

1st in class/category - \$12 (min of 3 shooters)

2nd in class/category - \$10 (min of 7 shooters)

3rd in class/category - \$9 (min of 11 shooters)

Team Tournaments

There will be 4 Team Tournaments conducted simultaneously. Awards for the team match will be given out per the team award schedule.

Tournament 1 - F-Open Rifle (Rule 3.4(a))

Tournament 2 - F-TR Rifle (Rule 3.4(b))

Tournament 3 - Any Rifle Any Sights (Rule 3.2 and 3.7(a) & 3.7(b))

Tournament 4 - Service Rifle (3.1a-e)

Combining Team Tournaments

A total of 5 more teams must be entered in a Tournament to establish a Tournament.

If there are less than 5 teams in Tournament 2 it will be combined with Tournament 1.

If there are less than 5 teams in Tournament 4 it will be combined with Tournament 3.

Teams shooting different types of rifles will compete as follows.

F-TR and F-Open will compete in the F-Open Tournament.

Any Rifle and Service Rifle will compete in the Any Rifle Tournament.

Team Award Schedule

Awards are on a per match basis.

NRA and Range Fees will be deducted from the team entry fees. The payouts are as follows:

1st – \$15 (Requires 5 Teams)

2nd – \$10 (Requires 8 Teams)

3rd – \$5 (Requires 11 Teams)

Team Aggregate

1st – \$20 (Requires 5 Teams) or 1 Team Aggregate Plaque (if requested)

2nd – \$15 (Requires 8 Teams)

3rd – \$10 (Requires 11 Teams)
